

In this installment in our series, we take a look at The Miners Club, Park City. We have included information on the resort, and some suggestions from the local staff.

CHECK-IN/OUT

Check-in is at 4 p.m. / Check-out is at 10 a.m. If you arrive before the room is ready, we can provide you with a key to use the pool area or you can relax in the Club Room on the first floor.

CHARGES AT CHECK-OUT

There will only be charges on your account if you charged to your room a movie rental, Wii rental or purchases from the Café (Winter Season).

PARKING

There is onsite parking for one vehicle per unit in the Miners Club parking garage. If you need to park additional vehicles, you will be provided with an offsite parking pass and instructions upon arrival.

RESTAURANT

The onsite Café is open during winter months only. Park City has a huge array of restaurant choices from fast food to five-star elegant dining.

POOL AND POOL CHAIRS

We have an outdoor heated pool and hot tub surrounded by a spacious pool deck with ample seating.

POOL TOWELS

Pool towels are provided in the units. Additional towels can be provided upon request.

BBQs

Two gas grills are located on our Club Room deck and are available anytime for guests to use.

EXERCISE FACILITIES

Our workout facility is available 24-hours a day. Workout towels are provided at the facility.

KIDS GAME ROOM

Open daily from 7 a.m. to 11 p.m.. Wii rental, ping pong, a foosball table, puzzles and board games are available.

RESTAURANTS & ACTIVITIES THE LOCALS AND STAFF LOVE

We recommend <u>Grappa</u>, which is Northern Italian cuisine; <u>Chimayo</u>, which is a great Southwestern restaurant; the <u>Riverhorse Cafe</u>, and <u>Mustang</u>, which are probably the two best steak and seafood restaurants in town. <u>Zoom</u> is another one with a more eclectic Continental menu that is probably the most popular restaurant in town. For lunch, favorites are <u>Windy Ridge Cafe</u> and <u>Cafe Terigo</u>.

For sleigh rides, we recommend <u>Rocky Mountain Recreation</u>. They have a rustic ranch area where they do sleigh rides and dinner, and it is a summer activities, which are all still available daily over there through the early fall.<u>The Olympic Park</u> is also open daily, and they too have an Alpine Slide and Zipline, in addition to a couple of Adventure Courses and their famous Winter Sports Museum (the slide, Zipline, and Adventure Courses are just available on weekends during the fall). Canyons resort also has their gondola ride, ziplines, and disc golf course open Saturday and Sunday.

Favorite family friendly restaurants are <u>Bandits</u> (Main St), <u>Maxwell's</u> (Kimball Junction/Redstone), <u>Baja Cantina</u> (Park City Mountain Resort), and <u>Cisero's</u> (Main St).

For brunch in Park City, we recommend either <u>Cisero's</u> or the <u>Silver</u> <u>Star Cafe</u>, both in downtown Park City.

There are three brew pubs here in town, and all of them have great food and beer. <u>Wasatch Brew Pub</u> is up on Main St, <u>Squatter's</u> is right on Hwy 224 on the way into town, and <u>Red Rock Brewery</u> is in Redstone at Kimball Junction, where you get off of the freeway. They are all local Utah companies. Additionally, <u>High West Distillery</u> is highly recommended and their restaurant and liquors are extremely popular. They are just off of the Main St downtown area on Park Avenue.

Although famous around the world for its winter activities, Park City is a four-season resort town.

<u>The Canyons</u> has a couple of ziplines- an easier beginner one, and one which is pretty breathtaking that goes over a big valley up on the mountain. One of the most popular activities during the winter is <u>Gorgoza Park</u>, which is a tubing hill that is a lot of fun.

For snowshoeing, the best company to use is <u>White Pine Touring</u>. Their rental shop and course are about a five minute drive from the resort, and they have a track you can go out on on your own. They also have guides that can take you out on a backcountry tour.

While spring is the off season and activities can be limited, it is still a great time to enjoy the scenery, dining, and shopping. There are many scenic drives in the area and a majority of the shopping opportunities are open year round. Salt Lake City is only 30 minutes away and offers all the amenities and night life of a major city.

There are a lot of popular, fun activities up here during the summer season. Aside from mountain biking, hiking, golfing, fishing, and many other mountain resort activities, <u>Park City Mountain Resort</u> has an Alpine Slide and Alpine Coaster, a Zipline, miniature golf, kid rides, and horseback riding, so they are one of the hot spots for summer fun up here. The Olympic Park is also open, and they also have an Alpine Slide and Zipline, in addition to a couple of Adventure Courses and their famous Winter Sports Museum.

The fun continues in fall.Aside from mountain biking, hiking, golfing, fishing, and many other mountain resort activities, Park City Mountain Resort has an Alpine Slide and Alpine Coaster, a Zipline, miniature golf, kids rides, and horseback riding, so they are one of the hot spots for For hiking and mountain biking, the three ski resorts here in Park City are the best places, as well as up Daly Canyon between Deer Valley and Park City Mountain Resort.
