## Know Before You Go

### CHECK-IN/OUT

Check-in is at 4pm and check-out is at 10am.

### CHARGES AT CHECK-IN/OUT

If you require WiFi for extra devices, there is a charge of US\$6 per day for up to two additional devices.

### PARKING

Complimentary self-parking is available onsite.

### RESTAURANTS

There are a variety of food and beverage choices available at this resort.

### BEACH AND POOL CHAIRS

For the enjoyment of all Members and guests, please note that beach

and pool chairs cannot be reserved. Any items left unattended will be collected for safe keeping by Security.

### POOL TOWELS

The towel stand located near the pool is open from 9 am - 6 pm daily. At check in Members are provided with one towel card for each two people staying in the room (one card = two towels). Just hand the attendant your card to receive your towels. When you return your towels you will receive your card back.

### BBQS

There are no BBQ grills onsite at this resort.

### EXERCISE FACILITIES

There is no exercise facility onsite

at this resort, however Members have complimentary access to the exercise facility at The Westin next door. The Westin charges for access to the following (payments only accepted in pesos):

- Wet areas of the gym \$200 pesos per person per day
- Tennis court \$295 pesos for two people per hour
- Night tennis (lighted court) \$395 pesos for two people per hour

## OUR STAFF RECOMMENDS (FAVORITE LOCAL SPOTS, ACTIVITIES, MUST SEE/DO)

### Thursdays Art & Market walk in the Marina Vallarta Area

Offered from 6pm – 10pm every Thursday from October through May, vendors set up stalls along the marina walk, across from the restaurants, offering everything from snacks, to art, to clothing.

### Botanical Gardens at Mismaloya Road

Located on over 20 acres of land, the botanical collection features over 3,000 different species of plants. "Our gardens are in a unique tropical dry forest ecosystem at 1,300 feet above sea level. Against the breathtaking backdrop of soaring mountain peaks, there is much to experience: Palm Gardens, Rose Garden, Tree Fern Grotto, Orchid House, Jungle Trails, Tropical Bird Watching, Agave Gardens, displays of Mexican Wildflowers and the Carnivorous Plant Collection. Bring your swimsuit and enjoy a refreshing dip in the crystal clear Rio Los Horcones." Did you know there are more orchid species found in Jalisco than in any other Mexican state? A current goal of the Botanical Gardens is the creation of the National Collection of Mexican Orchids, the most complete collection of Mexican orchids anywhere in the country. The gardens are open Tuesdays through Sundays (closed Monday) from 10am – 6pm and cost only \$150 pesos per person (children four and under are free).

### Vallarta's Artwalk & Malecon

The Malecon is Puerto Vallarta's boardwalk and is not to be missed. This mostly pedestrian-only seaside promenade is the best value in Vallarta because it's free. Stroll at your leisure, stopping when a store, statue, street performer or the stunning view of the Bay catches your attention. There are many vendors offering art, souvenirs, balloons, toys, drinks and food, renting or lending out bikes, skateboards, sketch artists, you name it, there's lots going on. If possible, be sure to time your visit to view the always amazing sunset. In the evening, the mood changes and as it gets later, the Malecon becomes the heart of the local nightlife. If you are an art lover, be sure to visit Vallarta's Artwalk. The participating galleries are within a few blocks of the Malecon, so you can really make a day and night of it.
